Purpose & Need

The following needs have been identified for the Project:

-  **Growing Demand for Electricity:**
Provide new capacity needed to serve new customer growth for both OPPD and Fremont in and around the Fremont area.
-  **Economic Development Opportunity:**
Enhance economic development opportunities in the area, by providing the necessary capacity to support new and expanding businesses and residential growth.
-  **Improved Reliability:**
Improve system reliability on both the OPPD and Fremont transmission systems. This project is a Southwest Power Pool reliability project.
-    **Diversifying Energy Portfolio:**
Augment Fremont's ability to diversify energy import options including additional renewables.

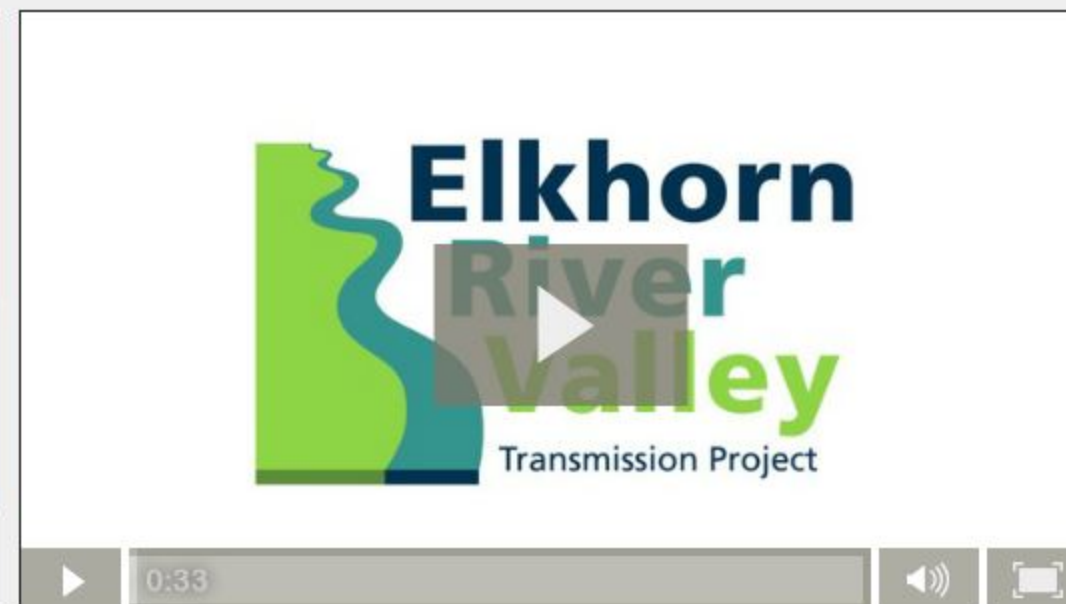

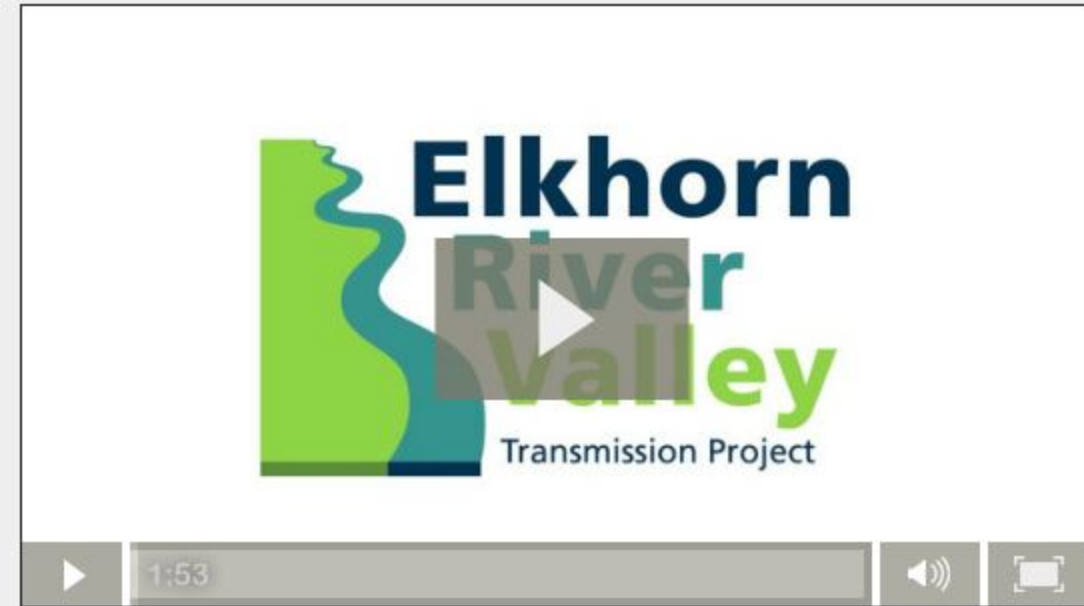
Route Selection Criteria

- Irrigation Systems/Center Pivots
- New and Platted Developments

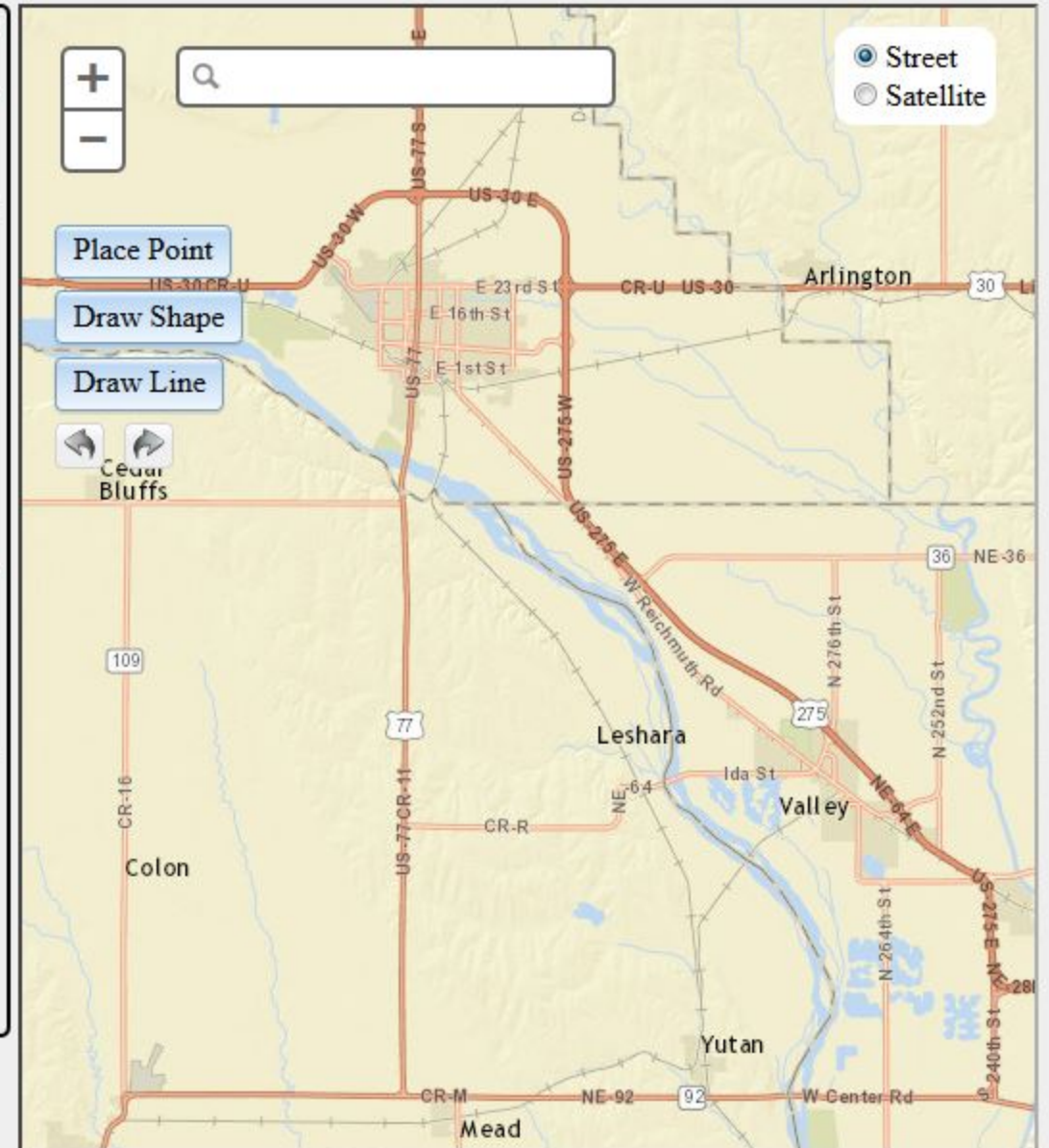
